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INTRODUCTION

Our Critical Care Transfer Stack (CCTS) has been developed to improve the internal transfer of critically ill patients within acute healthcare environments.

WHAT IS IT?

The CCTS is a mobile frame which attaches onto a bed to support vital life-saving medical devices such as monitors, ventilators, O_2 cylinders and accessories. These devices are mounted to the vertical aspect of the CCTS for visibility during patient transfer. The CCTS also safely transports cylinder holders, suction units, includes integrated storage areas and, crucially, has an integrated power supply unit.

There can be many risks when moving critically ill patients across specialised areas of a hospital. Having the right urgent care equipment that minimises those risks is paramount when transferring patients to critical care theatres and wards, as well as for transfer by outreach or resuscitation teams. Research by the Intensive Care Society in 2019 found equipment failure as the most common adverse event during patient transfer.

We have developed a CCTS that is designed to remain extremely robust within a high-stress environment and improve the level of support given to critical care intrahospital transfer. Our CCTS is the only product of its type able to interface with different bed types as the brackets used for the unit are flexible and universal to all bed models. Easily and securely connected, it allows beds to be moved as required and caters for varying ramp gradients without incurring damage when transferring in and out of theatre environments and constrained lift sizes.

MEDICAL CLASSIFICATION

Uniquely for these types of product, our CCTS has a medical device classification (Class I). It is UKCA marked, registered with the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) and is compliant with UK Medical Device Regulations (MDR).

The product has been rigorously tested for effectiveness across the 35 theatres based at Southampton General Hospital, as well as in General, Cardiac, Paediatric and Neuroscience intensive care units, and the Emergency department. Extensive feedback contributed to the development of the CCTS, with the final product receiving overwhelmingly positive reviews from hospital staff across a wide range of professions and specialties.

KEY BENEFITS

- Effectively creating a complete mobile ICU platform solution, this CCTS provides a unique combination of advantages for critical care transfer needs.
- An integrated power supply unit is protected by a medical grade power isolation transformer, developed specifically to provide an all-in-one functional and safety solution. Other devices supplied without this power source are able to avoid electrical testing requirements and can lead to electrical retrofit being carried out by different internal departments.
- Crucially, our CCTS provides for standardisation of intrahospital patient transfer nationwide, allowing all staff to be familiar with the process as they move between NHS sites and other healthcare organisations.

- The full suite of connected monitoring and life support equipment attached to the unit can be powered whilst stationary by the single detachable extension power lead. This also serves to charge the onboard batteries of the attached equipment.
- The requirement to move a critically ill patient from one bed type to another for transfer in emergency situations is not necessary with the unique multi-bed interface of the CCTS.
- The requirement to place medical devices on or around a patient is avoided, reducing risk of injury to the patient or staff due to manual handling, and damage to high-value equipment.
- This mobile platform solution ensures that medical support of critically ill patients is maintained in the case of on-site emergency requiring evacuation.
